Tommy Long, ACCD Chairman

Mr. Tommy Long has served on the Allen County Conservation District Board of Supervisors for fourteen years. He was appointed to complete the unexpired term as Vice Chairman in November 2006 following the passing of the late Frank Smith. In January 2007, Tommy Long was elected as Chairman and continues to serve in this position to present date. Tommy also currently serves on the Chamber of

Commerce Board. In years past, he has served on the Allen Co. Farmers Service Board (8 years), the Local Phase I AG Council board (6 years) and the Allen Co. Beef Cattlemen Association Board for more than 20 years.
